

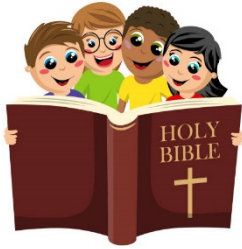

DISCOVER TOGETHER: **Share the Love**

READ TOGETHER:



"I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. ³⁵ By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."
John 13:34-35

TALK TOGETHER:

In **John 13:34-35**, Jesus gave a new commandment to his first disciples long ago, but the message is still clear today: Love one another. Because of Jesus' love for us, we can love one another. This is what identifies us as Jesus' followers. Express your love for one another through kind words, hugs, and high-fives.



Take turns sharing ways we can love others. Do you think it is ever hard for Jesus to love others? Think about the person it is hardest for you to love. How can Jesus help you love that person?
